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**MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)**

The present petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. for setting aside order dated 30.06.2020 and cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridabad in case FIR No.314, dated 27.06.2020, under Sections 498-A, 406, 506, 419, 420 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for respondent No.2 and on instructions from ASI Gulshan Kumar at the outset has apprised the Court that subsequent to the passing of the impugned order, offences under Sections 467, 468 and 471 IPC were added. Respondent No.2 then appeared and surrendered before the Court below on 09.03.2021 and was thereafter extended the concession of regular bail by the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1<sup>st</sup> Class, Faridabad. It has been submitted that in the aforementioned circumstances, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the above, the instant petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
