Case is taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

The grievance of the petitioners is in respect of the alleged railway recruitment scam. The petitioners allege coherence and connivance between respondent Nos.10 to 12, who, they allege, are enjoying patronage of respondent Nos.14 and 15 (the local MLA).

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though petitioner No.1 has already submitted a representation dated 12.02.2021 to the Director General of Police, Punjab, but the same has not been decided till date.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Avtar Singh Sandhu, Additional AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Mr. C.M. Munjal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 14 and 15.

The counsel for the respondents, stoutly contest and dispute the averments made in the present petition, but do not dispute the factum of the submission of the representation dated 12.02.2021 by petitioner No.1, as noticed above.

Thus, without going into the pleadings contained in the present petition, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Border Range, Feozepur, to look into the grievance of the petitioners, raised in the representation dated 12.02.2021 and decide the same, in accordance with law.
