The present writ petition has been filed for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent no. 2 to decide the statutory appeal filed by the petitioner against the orders dated 29.10.2018 (Annexure P-2 and P-3) passed by respondent no. 1 in a time bound manner.

On 15.07.2021, the following observations were made by this Court.

“Counsel prays for time to seek instructions as to how he is entitled for out of turn decision of appeals, as admittedly the petitioner is still in service and it is not that his retiral benefits as such are affected. Neither any recovery order as such has been placed on record qua the punishment orders (Annexures P-2 and P-3).

Two opportunities as such have been availed on 28.09.2020 and 26.11.2020 to show to this Court whether any such recovery order has been made in pursuance of punishment orders which would necessitate directions for decision of out of turn hearing of the appeal by this Court.

No such material has been placed on record.

Thus, it is apparent that there is no requirement to issue any such directions to the Appellate Authority and the present petition stands dismissed.
