The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Sh. Samarth Sagar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, has pointed out that the petitioner did not complete the work and therefore, the contract with the petitioner was terminated and now the work is being carried out by a fresh contractor.

Through this writ petition, the petitioner prays for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the alleged admitted dues of the amount i.e Rs.24,00,000/-. The petitioner claims that their trust (Feedback Foundation Charitable Trust) was allotted a work on 17.03.2020, for Integrated Decentralized Solid Waste Management in Kalka, Pinjore and Panchkula. The petitioner claims that the petitioner has completed the work, however, the payment has not been released.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he should be provided a copy of the order terminating his contract.

The learned State counsel has stated that the aforesaid order has already been supplied to the petitioner.

In any case, let the respondents supply another copy of the order to the petitioner terminating the contract in his favour.

With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
