MANOJ BAJAJ, J.

Petitioner has filed this third petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.228 dated 04.10.2020 under Sections 324, 323, 427, 452, 340, 148 and 149 Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 326 and 307 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar (Rural).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed for an adjournment.

The prayer is declined.

A perusal of the petition reveals that previously the petitioner had approached this Court for grant of pre arrest bail in the above FIR, on two occasions, but as the Court was not inclined to grant the concession, the petitions were withdrawn by the learned counsel on

15.01.2021 and 26.03.2021, respectively.

Apparently, this third petition based on the same cause of action is nothing but the misuse of the process of the Court, therefore, it is a fit case for burdening the petitioner with costs.

Resultantly, the petition is dismissed and it is ordered that the petitioner shall deposit a sum of Rs. 10,000/- with Punjab and Haryana High Court Employees' Welfare Association within a period of two months.

Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar shall ensure the recovery and deposit of the costs.
