This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to transfer the investigation of case FIR No.60 dated 17.05.2021 under Sections 120-B, 465, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Dhakoli, District S.A.S Nagar (Mohali) to some senior IPS Officer of district other than S.A.S Nagar (Mohali) and Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that grievance of the petitioner would be satisfied in case instant petition is treated as representation on behalf of the petitioner and if the same is ordered to be disposed of by respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh, in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh Multani, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2-Director General of Police, Punjab, Punjab Police Headquarters, Sector-9, Chandigarh, to treat the instant petition as representation and to look into and decide the same in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within four weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
