Case heard by video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.226, dated 13.05.2021, having been registered at Police Station City Sirsa, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 17/61/85/27-A of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the recovery allegedly made from the petitioner is shown to be before a gazetted officer, however even as per the FIR it is 125 grams of opium, which is far less than commercial quantity (which is above 250 grams).

Upon query to learned State counsel, as to whether there is any other criminal case registered against the petitioner, he submits that as per his instructions, there is no other case registered against him.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
