Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent No.4 to 8 as the petitioners have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has placed on record the affidavits dated 03.07.2021 of the petitioners stating therein that they have telephonically talk with their parents and also personally met with them. Their parents have decided to accept the marriage of the petitioners and assured their safety and wellbeing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submit that since the matter

has been settled between the parties, they do not want to press the present petition.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions of ASI Devi Dayal, Police Station Raipur Rani, submits that Salinder Kumar, father of petitioner No.1-Goldi, has already made a statement that he has no objection regarding the marriage of the petitioners. It has been informed that the petitioners have sent to Safe Home, Mansa Devi, Panchkula.
