Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.437 dated 23.09.2015, under Sections 420, 419, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Badshahpur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner and other accused had connived to fabricate general power of attorney of the complainant with a motive to grab 02 acres of prime land. He, however, contends that the general power of attorney was not utilized by any of the accused and no harm had been caused to the complainant in real terms as the case was registered prior to the execution of the sale deed. The petitioner is in custody for over 09 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Sanjeev Kumar states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 09 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
