It is contended that on account of matrimonial dispute with her husband Sukhdev Singh, petitioner Gurpreet Kaur has walked out of the matrimonial home along with three minor children; her husband is a drunkard and has been treating the petitioner with cruelty. Now, he is threatening the petitioner that he would eliminate her and remove the minor children forcibly.

She has approached this Court by way of filing the present petition seeking protection of her life and liberty and her minor children from her estranged husband and his relatives/associates. According to the petitioner, she had submitted a written representation dated 17.06.2021 addressed to Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, narrating her tale of woes but without evoking any response.

The present petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to look into the representation Annexure P-2 moved by the petitioner and if he finds that some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law.
