This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.160 dated 12.05.2016 registered under Sections 379/307/188/427/34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendergarh.

Custody certificate dated 26.07.2021 has been filed in Court by way of affidavit of Kuldeep Singh, Deputy Supdt., District Prison (Narnaul), (Mahendra Garh) Haryana, the same is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 10 months and 10 days.

Counsel for the petitioner states that all the other co-accused were acquitted.

Learned State counsel states that the present petitioner was arrested on 17.05.2016 and bailed out on 19.12.2016 but thereafter did not appear and was ultimately apprehended only on 21.04.2021 after about 4 ½ years. She has however not disputed the fact that the petitioner has undergone 10 months and 10 days of custody and all the other co-accused have been acquitted.

Be that as it may, keeping in view the above facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to release the petitioner on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

However, the trial Court will be justified in seeking heavy surety in view of the propensity of the petitioner.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
