RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the official respondents to take action on the representation dated 10.06.2021 (Annexure P-17) and to further issue directions to the official respondents to not commence any multiple inquiries on the same cause of action and on the same subject matter as firstly detailed inquiries have already been conducted and, secondly, civil suit is also pending.

Since, the prayer in the present petition is only for decision on the representation; and even a civil suit is disclosed to be pending regarding the matter, therefore, this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter. However, learned counsel for the respondents has pointed out that pursuant to the earlier order dated 09.04.2021 passed by this Court in CWP No.8267 of 2021, final decision on the subject matter involved in the representation has already been taken by the authorities. A copy of the same has been sent to learned counsel for the petitioners online.

As response to this, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternate remedy, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
