The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.192 dated 09.03.2021 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 IPC at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

On 29.06.2021, following order was passed by this Court:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that deficit amount is of Rs.2 lacs. Petitioner

undertakes to deposit the same in the court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul within 10 days.

Notice of motion for 14.07.2021.

Subject to deposit of deficit amount of Rs.2 lacs before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Narnaul within one week from today, petitioner shall be allowed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on interim bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case. The case shall be decided on merits on the adjourned date.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has complied with the aforesaid order.

This fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from ESI Devinder Singh and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 29.06.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on

joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
