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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a bail petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 603 dated 13.11.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 324 IPC (Section 307 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Narnaul, District Mahendergarh.

As per allegations in FIR, while complainant was going to fill up diesel in the pick up of his friend, Sachin, Ishwar, Vicky, Dharampal alongwith 2/3 other persons who were consuming liquor stopped his vehicle. Sachin removed key of vehicle of complainant and stated that he wanted to ply his vehicle. He later handed the key to complainant. Thereafter, when complainant was going to Mohalla Nalapur for taking household articles, then Dharmender and Mukesh (petitioner) caught hold of him and started hurling abuses to him. In the meantime, two other boys reached there. When Lalit came to rescue of complainant, then accused Vicky inflicted 2 knife blows in the stomach of complainant. The petitioner is also alleged to have inflicted injuries. Thereafter, on reaching the family members of complainant, they were rescued from assailants and they were admitted to Government Hospital, Narnaul.

Learned counsel for petitioner has argued that no injury attributed to petitioner is reflected in the MLR. He was only present there. The investigation in case is complete and challan has already been presented. Petitioner has been in custody since 5.1.2021.

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Without commenting anything on merit of case and also bearing in mind the investigation in the case is complete and the petitioner is in custody since 5.1.2021, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
