The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* by directing the respondents to release the pensionary benefits of the petitioner viz., Pension, Commuted Pension, Gratuity, Leave Encashment and G.P. Fund etc. on account of retirement alongwith interest @ 12 % per annum, for which, notice of demand dated 15.05.2021 (Annexure P-3) has also been served upon the respondents.

In the light of oral submissions of the petitioner side the directions are issued to respondents to duly consider the notice of demand dated 15.05.2021 (Annexure P-3) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.
