respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation of the petitioners (Annexure P-4) within the framework of law. Meanwhile, the official respondents shall ensure due protection of life and personal liberty of the petitioners and shall take prompt and immediate action in accordance with law, in case any instance of threat is brought to their notice by the petitioners. However, this order will not comment upon the legality and validity of the marriage claimed to be solemnized between the petitioners.

The present petition disposed off accordingly.

Upon specific request by the parents of the girl-petitioner No.1-Amandeep Kaur, that they want to reconcile the matter, the parties are directed to appear before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court on **28.06.2021 at 10:00 A.M.**, on which date, both the sides would appear before the Mediator. However, it be ensured that none of the parties take the law in their hands and the local police shall ensure maintenance of law and order.
