Application is allowed as prayed for. Annexure P-3 is taken on record.

Main case:

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 12.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had purchased one *kill*a of land situated in village Nizampur, Tehsil and District Ambala, vide registered sale deed bearing *Vasika* No. 530 dated 17.06.2020, from one Rachna Ram, and cultivating the same with her

husband. Now, the owners of the adjoining land are not allowing the petitioner to sow the crop and compelling the petitioner to transfer the land in their name.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the copy of sale deed dated 17.06.2020, which shows that the petitioner has purchased the land from Rachna Ram. The petitioner has submitted a representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Ambala and respondent No. 3-SHO, Police Station Sadar, Ambala, but no action has been taken by the police, so far.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner confines his prayer to the extent that the petitioner would be satisfied, if her aforesaid representation is decided by respondent No. 2, within a stipulated period.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 State only.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. Ashok Singh Chaudhary, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Ambala, to decide the representation dated 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order in accordance with law.
