Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition is filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in case FIR No.104 dated 15.03.2021, under Section 304-B IPC registered at Police Station Zirakpur, District SAS Nagar, Mohali (Punjab).

The FIR in question was registered by Jaswinder Singh, father of the deceased Ruby @ Ravinder Kaur, wherein the allegations contained against the petitioner who is the husband of the deceased Ruby @ Ravinder Kaur that she was subjected to the cruelty and harassment on account of demand of dowry due to which his daughter Ruby @ Ravinder Kaur committed suicide and thus, the present FIR under Section 304-B IPC was

registered.

It has been contended that the petitioner is behind bars since 15th March, 2021. Learned State counsel has submitted that after investigation, challan has been presented under Section 306 IPC and thus, the offence of Section 304-B IPC has been deleted. He further submits that the prosecution has filed an application for the discharge of the petitioner from the offence under Section 304-B IPC.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the Court finds that learned counsel for the petitioner has succeeded in making out a case for bail to the petitioner. The present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. Nothing said herein shall be treated as an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
