Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 407 and 482 Cr.P.C., praying for transfer of the petition under Sections 12, 18, 19, 20 and 22 of Protection of Women From Domestic Violence Act, 2005, Filing No.49747/2020 and registration No.8889/2020 filed on 26.10.2020 titled as Baljit Kaur Vs. Amani and others before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ludhiana, which is fixed for 30.07.2021.

It has been contended that petitioner No.1 is married with the son of respondent. The marriage took place on 26.01.2020 at Mansa. It is further contended that due to the cruel behaviour of the respondent, marriage could not stand. Petitioner No.1 had to file a litigation for the redressal of her grievances.

In the present petition, the contentions have been raised that as the other petitions are already pending in Mansa, so the above-mentioned petition which is filed at Ludhiana, be also transferred to the

same Court at Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it would be a great inconvenience for the petitioners to travel from Mansa to Ludhiana as applicant No.2 is suffering from old age problems.

I have heard counsel for the petitioners.

I find no merit in the arguments raised before this Court. The contentions raised by the counsel for the petitioners do not find any place for the transfer of the case as provided under Section 407 Cr.P.C.

Resultantly, the petition being devoid of any merits is hereby dismissed.
