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By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'anticipatory bail' under the provisions of Section 438 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.20, dated 15.03.2017, having been registered at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 420/465/467/468/471/120-B of the IPC.

Though on the last date of hearing it had been observed by this court that if learned counsel for the petitioners did not appear to argue the matter on the next date of hearing the interim order would be vacated, however learned State counsel submits that, as per his instructions from ASI Tilak Raj, the petitioners having joined investigation pursuant to the order passed by this court on 14.10.2019, their custodial interrogation in fact is not required,

especially with the matter having been compromised between the parties.

That being so, with no comment made on the actual merits of the case, in terms of the instructions of learned State counsel from ASI Tilak Raj, this petition has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

It is also to be noticed that in these two petitions, as have been listed alongwith the aforesaid petition, quashing of the FIR in question is sought. A report has been received from the learned JMIC, Gurdaspur, dated 23.01.2020, stating to the effect that respondents no.2 and 3 in those petitions had appeared before that court and had stated that a compromise has indeed been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel for respondents no.2 and 3 however not being present to confirm that the compromise still subsists between the parties or not, almost 2 years having gone by since that date, adjourned to 07.03.2022.
