Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during the pendency of the petition, the respondents have formulated another scheme for extension of time period to defaulter allottees and when the petitioner went to apply for the same, he was informed that because his writ petition is pending, his application could not be entertained. As per him, during this interregnum, the last date has expired and the limited prayer made today is that he will withdraw the writ petition and will approach the respondents but they may not decline his application only on the ground that the last date has expired.

Mr. Dhandi, counsel for the respondents made a statement that that in view of the pendency of the writ petition, if the petitioner makes an application within 10 days from today, the same will be considered and will not be declined only on the ground that the last date has expired.

In view of the statement made above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the respondents.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
