Case taken up through video conferencing.

It is stated that petitioner No.1– Tulsi, aged about 21 years has got married with petitioner No.2 – Ajay, aged about 23 years against wishes of her family members, arrayed as respondents No.4 to 6, who are threatening to interfere in their marital life, as such to seek protection in that regard, they have approached this Court by way of filing the present petition.

Notice of motion to official respondents No.1 to 3.

Ms. Vasundhara Dalal Anand, Addl. PP, UT Chandigarh, accepts notice on behalf of such respondents. She has stated that the local police had recorded statements of Inder Pal and Chanderwati, respondents No.4 and 5 in the petition, who are parents of petitioner No.1 and they had stated that they have no objection to the marriage between the petitioners. Learned counsel for UT Chandigarh further states that she has forwarded copies of such statements in the Whatsapp group.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that he has gone through such statements and in view of the same, since the petitioners do not apprehend any immediate threat at the hands of private respondents, as such, he be permitted to withdraw the instant petition. Allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
