This writ petition has been filed under Article 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside summon bearing No. 01/R2A3B1819GGS001 dated 13.4.2021 (Annexure P-1) issued by the office of respondent No.3 under Section 70 of the Haryana Goods and Service Act, 2017 and subsequent proceeding there to.

2. On the last date the following order was passed :-

“The precise contention raised in the present case is against the simultaneous proceedings initiated by both the Centre and the State.

Notice of motion. Notice regarding stay.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sunish Bindlish, Advocate accepts notice n behalf of respondents No.1, 5 and 6 and Ms. Mamta Singla, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 2 to 4.

Counsel for the respondents seeks an adjournment.

Adjourned to 15.7.2021."

3. Learned State counsel has very fairly stated that now the State of Haryana has withdrawn the proceedings initiated by it against the petitioner which is admitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner. Consequently, the petition has been rendered infructuous.
4. In view of these circumstances, the petition stands dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
5. Since the main case has been decided, the pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
