The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of *certiorari* over an order dated 26.04.2021 (Annexure P-1) and over another order dated 04.03.2021 (Annexure P-9).
