This petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.42 dated 05.06.2020 under Sections 406, 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Women Police, Chandigarh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case and on the direction of this Court, has joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the main FIR having been quashed on the basis of compromise vide separate order of even date passed in CRM-M-42775-2020, the instant application for anticipatory bail has been rendered infructuous and is accordingly, disposed of.
