Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the latest medical certificate of father of the petitioner dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) to assert that the petitioner is entitled to consideration for release on emergency parole so that he can take care of his father, who is seriously ill. He has further asserted that an earlier request for emergency parole was rejected by the respondents vide order dated 06.10.2020 (Annexure P-1).

Counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the fact that subsequent to the issuance of certificate dated 01.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) by the Doctor, he has not approached the competent authority for grant of emergency parole.

If that be so, let the petitioner first approach the competent

authority for grant of emergency parole. In case the petitioner approaches the authority concerned for the said relief, the same shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a period of two weeks from the date of submission of such application.

The petition accordingly stands disposed of.
