Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for quashing of the transfer order dated 09.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.2 whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Narnaul to Rewari, in public interest qua private-respondent No.3, Rakesh.

Counsel has vehemently submitted that another Driver is available at Narnaul who has been there since 2017.

A perusal of the paperbook would go on to show that petitioner and respondent No.3 inter se were transferred on 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-2). After a period of almost 3 years, the transfer has again taken place, for administrative reasons. In such circumstances, this Court does not deem fit to entertain the present writ petition, as it is settled principle that while exercising the extraordinary writ jurisdiction, this Court would not interfere in the absence of any mala fides in transfer matters.

Resultantly, in view of the above, no case is made out to entertain the present writ petition and the same is dismissed in limine.
