Case taken up through video conferencing.

This second petition for pre-arrest bail has been filed by petitioner – Rani, an accused in FIR No.71 dated 23.6.2020, under Sections 22 of NDPS Act, registered with Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala. The first petition filed by the petitioner was dismissed vide a detailed order dated 23.7.2020 passed in CRM-M-20080-2020 for the reason that while being intercepted by the police party, she had statedly thrown the contraband weighing 252 gms. and managed to run away and further, she was involved in five more cases. Though as it comes out from the record, she had been arrested and she moved an application for grant of interim bail for the reason that report from FSL had not been received. In view of ratio of authority **Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and others Versus State of Punjab, 2014(3) RCR(Criminal) 953 (DB)**, the Judge, Special Court, Kapurthala

considering that fact as well as on account of outbreak of Covid-19 Pandemic granted her interim bail vide order dated 21.10.2020. She was required to surrender as per undertaking given by her but she did not do so resultantly non-bailable warrants were issued against her by Judge, Special Court, Kapurthala. Now she has approached this Court again for grant of pre-arrest bail.

After arguing for sufficient time, realizing that the Court was not inclined to grant the relief, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner states that she be permitted to withdraw the present petition.

Permission is granted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
