Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.09 dated 08.01.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

On 30.06.2021, a Coordinate Bench of this Court has passed the following order:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has already cleared both the bank loans and No Due Certificate has been issued by the Bank on 01.11.019 though with the recital that the account has already been declared fraud and reported to RBI and inquiry is pending. In case of co-accused Jaj Singh, interim order dated 21.05.2021 has been passed in CRM-M No.19506 of 2021.

Notice of motion for 25.08.2021.

In the meanwhile, petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 05.07.2021 at 11.00 A.M. and in the event of his arrest, he shall be enlarged on *interim* bail, subject to his furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioner shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case. The case shall be decided on merits on the adjourned date.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.19506 of 2021.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Shamsheer Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 30.06.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
