For the reasons as are mentioned in the application, the same is *allowed*. Documents i.e. Annexures P-9 & P-10 attached with the application are taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

Main Case

1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court to move a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the petition for regular bail, expeditiously.

2. The same is not opposed to by learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the complainant.

3. Accordingly, in the light of statement of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is dismissed as withdrawn, with the liberty as prayed for. In the eventuality of the petitioner moving a petition for regular bail before the learned trial Court, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law, expeditiously, by taking into account all aspects of the matter.

4. This order shall also dispose of all pending misc. applications.
