1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Learned counsel states that in view of order dated 09.07.2021, having been passed by the respondents in compliance of order dated 17.08.2020 in CWP No.10865 of 2020, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 09.07.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
