The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.158 dated 09.07.2020, under Sections 307, 323, 324, 341, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is alleged to have given a 'datar' blow on the head of the injured Jatinder Singh who has fully recovered from the injury. The petitioner is in custody for almost a year since his arrest on 15.07.2020. He is not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Darshan Singh, contends that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for almost a year, the COVID-19 pandemic, he is not involved in any other criminal case and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
