This is a petition that has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking temporary parole for 15 days to the petitioner on account of death of his father namely Sube Singh, for attending last rites, rituals and Tehrahvi ceremony under Section 3(1)(b) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 2007.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepshikha Chauhan, AAG, Haryana appearing through the medium of video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. She, on instructions from Inspector Sanjeev, SHO of the Police Station concerned would affirm that the father of the petitioner has died.

Keeping in view the averments made in the petition supported with the document annexed, the presence of the petitioner appears to be

necessary to perform last rites of his father. The instant petition is allowed.

The petitioner is directed to be released on temporary parole for a period of two weeks on his furnishing requisite bonds with the authorities concerned.
