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**HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.**

Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner.

The petitioner is a widow and she married her daughter namely, Manmeet Kaur with respondent No.4 on 18.11.2019. The case of the petitioner is that as agreed between the parties, the daughter of the petitioner went to Canada for further studies and respondent No.4 and his family members were to bear the expenses in that regard as respondent No.4 was to join her in Canada. However, the immigration papers of respondent No. 4 to go to Canada were rejected because of which he

could not join the daughter of the petitioner in Canada. Thereafter matrimonial dispute arose between the daughter of the petitioner and respondent No.4. The family members of respondent No.4 are harrasing the petitioner to meet the expenses of the stay of her daughter in Canada.

The grievance of the petitioner is that she is repeatedly being called to the police Station in particular by respondent No.3. The petitioner is not served by a written summon though she had visited the office of DSP Moga in response to verbal summons from his office. The petitioner has no concern with the matrimonial dispute between her daughter and respondent No.4. The petitioner is being harassed by respondent No.3 without disclosing any complaint or case against her.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondents that in case the presence of the petitioner is required in connection with investigation/inquiry of any case the provisions of Section 160 Cr.P.C be complied with.
