The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served. However, he remains unrepresented.

This transfer application has been filed by the respondent's wife to transfer the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as 'Ravi Kumar vs. Shivani' pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division-1, Ferozepur to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda.

It is the case of the petitioner that she is presently residing at Bathinda which is 107 kms away from Ferozepur and is also maintaining her minor child who is about 1 ½ years old. It has further been submitted that a complaint before Women Cell, Bathinda (a Division of the Punjab Police) is also pending.

In view of the aforesaid, the transfer application is allowed.

It is directed that the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu

Marriage Act, 1955, titled as 'Ravi Kumar vs. Shivani' pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge, Senior Division-1, Ferozepur be transferred to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Bathinda. The transferor court is directed to remit the file of the case to the transferee court forthwith. The parties through their counsel are directed to appear before the District & Sessions Judge, Bathinda on 29.09.2021, who shall either try the case himself or assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction in the District.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
