Pursuant to the earlier order passed, an affidavit of the DSP, Headquarters, Bhiwani, has been filed, which is ordered to be taken on record.

Learned State counsel draws specific attention to paragraphs 20 and 21 of the preliminary submissions of that affidavit, to submit that other than the deceased in respect of whom the FIR was registered, two witnesses in the case, i.e. one Pawan and Sube Singh, were also murdered on 14.10.2019 and 15.07.2020 respectively, and though the petitioner is not seen to be accused of those two murders, he is very much seen to be an accused in the FIR in question presently and consequently, with three murders eventually having taken place, admitting him to bail may endanger some other persons' life.

Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press this petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
