The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

As per the office report, notice issued to the respondent has been received back served. However, he remains un-represented.

Through this application, the petitioner (wife) prays for transfer of the petition filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage At, 1955, titled as “Vishal Khullar Vs Pooja Rani”, pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court Jagraon, to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the respondent is already defending proceedings in a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Barnala. The distance between Jagraon and Baranala is 60 Kms and the petitioner is unable to defend the petition as she has no source of income. She claims that she is dependant on her parents.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the application is allowed. The file of case titled as “Vishal Khullar Vs. Pooja Rani”, is transferred from the Court of Principal Judge Family Court, Jagraon to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

The petitioner is directed to appear before the Court of District Judge, Barnala on 06.09.2021.

The transferor Court is requested to remit the case file to the transferee Court forthwith.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
