The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has filed the present (first) application under Section 482 read with Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of interim bail in case FIR No. 102 dated 17.03.2021 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Naraingarh, District Ambala on the ground that she is suffering from various ailments including cardiac problem and diabetes.

The petition has been opposed by the respondent State in terms of reply filed by way of affidavit of Anil Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Naraingarh, District Ambala in the Registry which is taken on record.

In the reply, it has been mentioned that at the time of arrest or thereafter, the accused-petitioner did not submit treatment record, if any before the IO or before the Medical Officer and during her medico-legal examination she was found medically fit in all respects. In case, she is granted bail she would tamper with the prosecution evidence as the material witnesses in the present case are yet to be examined.

At this stage, learned Counsel for the petitioner states that

the petitioner does not want to continue with the present petition and the same may be dismissed as withdrawn with direction to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala to provide her requisite medical treatment from PGI, Chandigarh or some other multi-speciality Hospital.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

The Superintendent Central Jail, Ambala is directed to get the petitioner medically examined from some Specialist Doctor of Civil Hospital, Ambala and then provide her medical treatment from PGI or some other Multi-speciality Hospital, if so required in view of her ailments.

A copy of this order be supplied to learned State Counsel and be also sent to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala for ensuring requisite compliance.
