Petitioners claim that they have attained majority and married against the wishes of their family members. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, they have filed the present petition for protection.

Petitioners claim to have submitted a representation (Annexure P-5) dated 27.6.2021 in this regard to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, AAG, Punjab present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State. Copy supplied.

The petitioners have placed on record copies of Aadhar Cards of petitioner Nos.1 and 2 as Annexures P-1 and P-3 as proof of their age as well as photographs and copy of certificate (Annexure P-4) regarding performance of marriage.

This petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Station House Officer, Police Station Batala, District Gurdaspur, to look into the representation Annexure P-5 dated 27.6.2021 and ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

However, it is made clear that this order shall not be treated as stamp of the Court about the marriage of the parties and no opinion regarding the validity of the marriage has been expressed.
