The petitioner has filed the present (first) petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.33 dated 17.03.2021 registered under Section 324 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Shahpur Kandi, District Pathankot.

In the course of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner has conceded that the offence punishable under Section 324 of the IPC is bailable and has accordingly prayed for dismissal of the petition as withdrawn with liberty to approach the Illaqa/Duty Magistrate for grant of bail on the ground of offence being bailable.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
