By this petition, filed under the provisions of Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing respondents no.2 and 3 to provide her adequate security and to protect her life and liberty at the hands of respondent no.4, who is alleged to be interfering in the peaceful life of the petitioner.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits (without making any other arguments at all and without any query from this court), that the petitioner does not wish to pursue this petition as she would be approaching the police authorities, who have already assured her of redressing her grievance.

Without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, this petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty always available to her to file a similar petition if her grievance is not addressed.

It is made clear again that this court has made no comment on whether the grievance of the petitioner is genuine or not.
