The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.50 dated 16.05.2021, under Sections 458, 440, 506, 427, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner was sitting in a car being driven by co-accused Jugraj Singh which smashed the gate of the house of the complainant. It is also alleged that the occupants of the car including the petitioner had allegedly threatened the complainant. He also contends that there was no physical altercation.

This Court, by the order dated 30.06.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 30.06.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
