Prayer in this petition is for issuance of directions to the respondents to register an FIR in cognizable offence against the accused persons mentioned in the complaint as well as representation dated 08.05.2021 and 24.05.2021, respectively.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to an incident dated 07.05.2021, wherein the accused persons, as named in the petition and aforesaid complaint/representation, submitted to the police authorities, the family members of the petitioner have suffered multiple injuries by fire arms.

Learned counsel relies upon MLRs of three victims as the well as the photographs showing that they were injured in the incident. It is further submitted that till date, no action has been taken on the complaint/representation of the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, who is also

appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that FIR No. 145 dated 07.05.2021 was registered against the petitioner's side, however, no cross version has been registered.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2-Superintendent of Police, Nuh to look into the matter and decide the aforesaid representation of the petitioner after going through the entire medical records and the statement of victims who have suffered injuries from the petitioner's side.
