In the present writ petition, the grievance which is being raised by the petitioner is that though, all the proceedings which were initiated against him have already come to an end but, his death-cum-retiral gratuity as well as commuted value of pension are not being released to him by the respondents, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents at the outset submits that the competent authority has already passed an order dated 16.03.2021 for releasing the DCRG and commuted value of pension to the petitioner and the copy of the said order has already been conveyed to the petitioner. The copy of the said order has also brought to the notice of this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, two weeks have already elapsed since the passing of the order dated 16.03.2021 but, no benefits in terms of the said order have been given to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case, order

dated 16.03.2021 has not been complied with so far, the same will be complied with within a period of four weeks from today positively and the benefits, for which, the petitioner is entitled for, in terms of order dated 16.03.2021 will be released to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that a liberty be given to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the grant of interest on delayed payments in case, the same is not granted by the respondents.

A liberty is granted to the petitioner to approach the respondents for the same by filing an appropriate representation in case, the petitioner feels that he is entitled for interest on the ground that the delay in releasing the benefits is attributed to the respondents and that too without any valid justification.

No further orders are required.

The present writ petition stands disposed of in above terms.
