The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.27 dated 15.03.2021 registered under Sections 21, 22 of the NDPS act and Section 61 of the Excise Act at Police Station Dhanaula, District Barnala.

While issuing notice of motion on 30.06.2021, this case was ordered to be heard along with CRM-M No.17176 of 2021 and said order shall form part of this order as well. Vide order of even date passed in CRM-M No.17176 of 2021, the interim anticipatory bail granted to the co-accused on 23.04.2021 has been made absolute.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of order dated 30.06.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

This fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from SI Jaskaran Singh and submits that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is no more required as he has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 30.06.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
