The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Through this revision petition, the petitioner has assailed the correctness of the order passed by the learned District Judge, Panipat, refusing to transfer two cases arising from a marital discord from the Court of Learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Panipat, to any other court. Learned District Judge, after discussing various aspects of the case and working of the Presiding Judge, has found that the allegations made by the petitioner are not correct. It has been found that the Presiding Judge during outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic allowed the parties to physically appear before her in order to expedite the disposal of the cases. No doubt, some time, in such matters expectation of the parties for expeditious disposal are high, however, the Presiding Judges have their own limitations. The Presiding Judge has already clubbed two connected cases pending before her. The Presiding Judge has been

giving short adjournment in order to expedite the disposal. Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.
