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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order dated 17.06.2021 in CWP No.11010 of 2021, the respondents have rejected the representations submitted by the petitioner vide order dated 25.06.2021 therefore, he does not wish to press the contempt petition and may be granted liberty to challenge order dated 25.06.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law. Since order dated 25.06.2021 has been passed by the respondents in compliance of order dated 17.06.2021 in CWP No.11010 of 2021, there is sufficient compliance with the orders of the High Court, therefore, no action is required to be taken against the respondent(s) under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

3. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 25.06.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.
