Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.95 dated 25.6.2020 registered under Sections 498-A, 406 IPC at Police Station Matour, SAS Nagar, Mohali.

Vide order dated 18.9.2020, the parties were referred the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. In pursuance to which they appeared before the Mediation Centre and the Mediation Centre has sent its report dated 22.9.2020, wherein it has been confirmed that no compromise could be arrived at between the parties, thus, the matter is sent back to this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and after a detail interaction, it is transpired that the amount offered by the petitioner side and

the same which is demanded by the complainant side cannot be negotiated. I find myself convinced that there would be no useful purpose if the parties are again referred for the mediation and the case is to be finally decided on merits by the Court.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and no more required for further investigation and they are in a position to complete the same and file the challan shortly.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 23.7.2020 granting the interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute and the petition stands allowed.
