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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 79 dated 23.5.2021 registered under Section 15 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Raipur Rani, District Panchkula.

As per allegations in FIR, one Mohit was found in possession of 100 kg. (5 bags) of poppy husk. It is the case of prosecution that Mohit in his disclosure statement stated that he had purchased 12 bags of poppy husk from petitioner.

Learned State counsel has also relied on call details between petitioner and accused Mohit. He states that on the mobile number registered in the name of petitioner, 155 calls were exchanged between petitioner and accused Mohit within a period of 3 months. Petitioner is also stated to be involved in another FIR registered under NDPS Act.

Learned counsel for petitioner has contended that accused Mohit and petitioner have been engaged to work in a poultry farm and that they are close relatives. As such, phone calls were exchanged between them.

At this stage, it is not possible to appreciate these contentions of learned counsel for petitioner.

Considering the antecedents of petitioner as also fact that it has been specifically stated by accused Mohit in his disclosure statement that petitioner had supplied huge quantity of poppy husk to him, it is not deemed appropriate to grant anticipatory bail to petitioner.

Dismissed.
