The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.407 dated 21.11.2020 under Sections 306 and 34 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Sector 50, Gurugram.

The case of the petitioner was that there was no material on record much less any suicide note to suggest that the petitioner had abetted the suicide of the deceased on account of his illicit relations with the wife of the deceased.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 11.02.2020 petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Dharambir Singh states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 30.06.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
